Samskritam is a well-formed, perfected and most ancient language. The earliest literature of the world is written in this language only. Though old, it is a highly technical, systematic, phonetically perfect and scientific language.

Samskritam literature encompasses a rich tradition of Vedas, Upanishads, Poetry, drama as well as scientific, technical, musical medical, mathematical, philosophical, legal dharmic and other texts.

During the course of their study, students will be exposed to learning shravya(hearable) and drshya(seeable) types of kavyas. The grammar component aims at equipping the ardent students with necessary skill sets to understand the language all by themselves.
